Player Practice Sessions	Please make sure your team is well prepared. Players have found the practice sessions essential to their understanding of the interface.
Format of the event	13 matches of 8 boards: played over 5 sessions (either 3 or 2 matches per session).  No team will play their own nation. Each match is 55 minutes long.  Players join sessions 15 minutes before the start time. If you are late starting a match, there are mandatory fines.
Entry Fee	Most teams have paid the €40 entry fee. If you have not, please pay it as soon as possible.
The mitigation of risks	Teams should be prepared for last-minute difficulties with connections, etc.  Teams who have only four players should have reserve players prepared (who are fully experienced in using RealBridge, understand the Conditions of Contests, and are from the same nation as their team).  Teams with more than four players should have one player on standby in addition to the four who are scheduled to play.
